Truth. Don't we all want to know what that is? Election time is here again and it would be great to be able to sort out the truth from all the conflicting statements! Our consumer society bombards us with their version of the truth about almost everything. We struggle ourselves to always be truthful and it is dangerous to believe we can determine the truth on our own for we are all fallible.

Today's scripture lessons testify to what is and has been truth since the beginning of time - that truth embodied in the Triune God. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. 
