Before worship

Have you ever felt like life is not fair? Nothing is working out? Everything seems to be falling out of place? You have even questioned your faith. I have been there and I was there recently. In 1 Kings 17 we read about where the Lord spoke to Elijah. Elijah listened and followed the Lord. From listening to God he went to a widow and was able to save her life and her son. So good. Then the women told Elijah "Now I know for sure that you are a man of God, and that the Lord truly speaks through you". From reading this story in 1 Kings, I hope and pray you are able to listen to God where He is calling you to go (places we never thought you would go). This is called stepping out in faith where the future is unknown but trusting God with that. Through the tough times we need to remember who we are and who God calls us to be (search the Bible for these answers if you need to refresh yourself on who you are and who God calls you to be). God is always enough for us. Even when we feel we have nothing left, God is up to something.

Confirmation

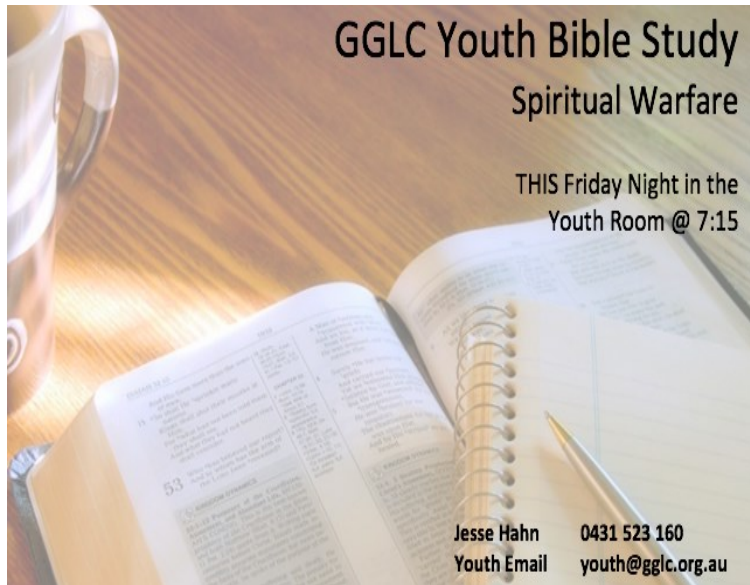

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be **8.00 am** on Friday **15th July 2016** for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Cnr Sunnybrook Drive & Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am. Arrival back in Adelaide will be at about 6.00 pm including a stop for lunch along the way.

Other costs: The evening meals on Friday and Sunday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$20/head for 2 meals. It is envisaged that we will go to the Elliston Hotel (walking distance) for a meal on the Saturday night. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast.
