### Before worship

#### Let he who is without sin...

How 'good' are you? But before you answer that, perhaps I should add some guidelines:

When was the last time you welcomed a stranger and opened your home to them?

When was the last time you showed affection to someone special in public?

When was the last time you spent an extravagant amount of money buying something others would enjoy – but where you received minimal or no return?

In today's society it can be much easier (and more widely accepted) to put yourself first, and then think about others – if you have time after...

I am sure that in Jesus' day, many people would have thought similarly: "They're not Jewish!"- "I'm glad I'm not like other people..."-"what a waste of valuable perfume"- "what sins did the parents commit?"-"He would know what kind of woman she is".

However Jesus caused those around him to think differently – placing others' needs first, because He understood His purpose. Jesus didn't only come for the 'good' people – He came for ALL people, whether their sins were large or small, known or unknown, those with troubled lives and those whose path was smoother.

Jesus comes to us still today – our lives ARE messy: we mess up; we get life wrong; and we definitely can't call ourselves 'good' (well, I know I can't!), but He loves us regardless. Jesus death and resurrection is very relevant – in a world seeking security, Jesus comes to us and all we have to do is put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Him. And when we simply do this, other blessings will flow in ways we cannot even imagine.

## Birthing Kits for Papua New Guinea-Asaroka

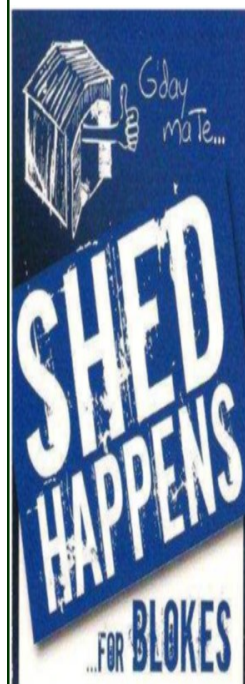
The date for the next packing & assembling birthing kits will be **Wednesday 22nd June 1-3pm & 7-9pm** in the Fellowship Centre.

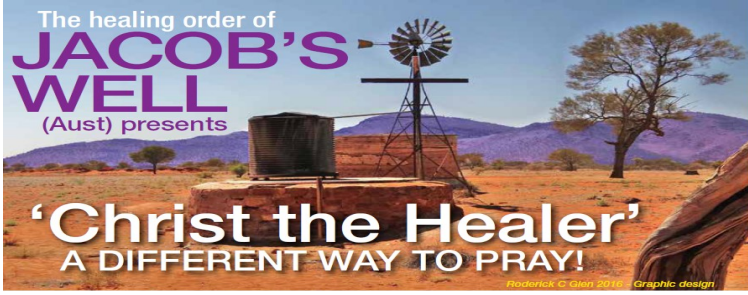
