#### Before worship

Today's reading from Galations 3 paints clear pictures of life with and without the good news of grace. Legal jargon is used to describe life without grace - being under law like its always our legal guardian, being in custody with no escape, and being classified (and thus victimised) by race, financial status or gender.

Contrast this with life that participates in Christ through faith. Now it is all about family - we are God's own children, part of His eternal family. It's about being cared for (clothed) and about our total acceptance without any regard for our race, position or gender. We are shown grace beyond measure.

The contrast is quite stark. The freedom we have in Christ is so attractive and encompassing, how could anyone choose anything else? Yet they do (sometimes we do too) - just as the people of Gerasenes who would rather have their pigs and demons than the healing and saving presence of Christ.

The reality is that not all want faith that transforms from sinner to saint, from enslaved to free, from being under obligation to being a chosen and loved child. Some prefer to be able to look down on others as their inferior, some prefer to be under the authority of others because they don't have to take responsibility for their own actions and some feel safe locked in the custody of familiarity - good or bad, like the comfort of an old pair of slippers.

Triune God, we thank You for the gift of faith. May we embrace our freedom and live the joy of Your grace. Let our joy and love witness to those who are disillusioned with their life under law, and may they respond to Your love and invitation to faith in Jesus Christ and join us in the freedom of grace. Amen.

#### WEST COAST FISHING TRIP

When: Fishing days are Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> Jul 2016 and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2016. Fishing locations will be selected during days prior to the event dependent on weather etc. Previous trips have included surf fishing at Locks Well, Talia Beach and Mt Camel Beach and Jetty Fishing at Elliston.
