Devotion

Good Fruit

I love fruit and I eat a lot of it. In summer it is the juicy stone fruit that gets me and in winter the delicious apples and pears keep me satisfied. I like fruit more than vegetables even though they are both good for me. When I open the fridge and look at the vegetable drawer, I'm not tempted to grab some celery or pumpkin. But when I walk past the fruit bowl, I naturally grab a perfectly-ripened pear or a handful of grapes.

So too with the fruit of the Spirit. In Galatians 5:22-23 Paul writes that 'the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control'. Who doesn't love those characteristics in others? When I encounter someone who is demonstrating the fruit of the Spirit, I want to be around that person and I want to get to know them much better. I am more joyful when I am with someone who is living joy. I am more peaceful when I am around someone who is at peace in their life. It goes without saying that I am more loving when I am surrounded by people who embrace giving and receiving love. I want the fruit of the Spirit to be overflowing in my life.

The great thing is, the fruit of the Spirit is **of the Spirit**. I know that I often live with no patience, gentleness, self-control or peace. But I know where I can find it. These things do not come from us, we don't generate them internally. God gives us the fruit of the Spirit as a gift when we come to Him and allow the Spirit of God to be active in our lives and to guide our thoughts and actions. So when I am running low on joy, I can ask God our Father to top me up with His Spirit and experience His joy. I can also seek out fellow Spirit-filled believers who are joyful. See when Paul lists the fruit of the Spirit it isn't a table of obligations but a promise that we can receive these things when we come to God with an open heart. Praise to God who blesses us with His Spirit.
