## Devotion

Carrying each other's burdens

The bible gives us many examples of the people of God helping each other in times of trouble and when life is difficult. Our God understands that we will encounter tough times; in fact Jesus told us to expect life to be anything but smooth sailing. When he was speaking to his followers in the sermon on the mount, Jesus said that we should consider ourselves blessed when we are insulted or persecuted for His names sake. Not if, but when we experience trials, we can expect our God to be with us, supporting us and providing assistance. One of the most obvious ways is through other members of God's family.

A lady named Tabitha was always available to help the needy (Acts 9), Saul's son Jonathan helped David escape when Saul wanted to kill him and Aaron was always on hand to assist Moses. In our reading today Paul writes 'Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfil the law of Christ' (Gal 6:2). Paul wasn't making a new decree for the congregation, rather he was reminding them of how God has operated with and among His people from the very beginning. It's why we consider our church home a family. Families are there in the good times and bad, and when one of us is in need we can expect the family to show God's care through His people.

Two ways we can help those around us with their burdens is to listen and to pray. How often we struggle alone with the troubles of life because we feel it would be unfair to talk to someone else about it, after all everyone has got problems right? But the bible tells us to be confident of sharing the burdens of life with our brothers and sisters. And we are asked by Jesus to truly listen to those who give us the privilege of sharing their concerns with us. We can also be confident that when we pray for another our Lord will hear and answer our prayers. May we all be blessed in the sharing of one another's burdens.

Things are starting to move now with our 3rd Container (*currently in the Carpark*) for school resources for our partnership schools at Asaroka in PNG. However we are still waiting on some important information from Asaroka regarding their targeted needs with textbooks. We need to get this all sorted and acquire these books from our usual source and get them palletised and loaded first up BEFORE we can start loading any other goods. Once I get this list I will let you know what else you may be able to assist in providing. Please be aware that there is already a substantial amount of targeted goods that have been pledged that I believe will already fill what room is left once the important books go in. ## Asaroka Container Appeal

We are now commencing an appeal in preparation for sending the container off to PNG as soon as it is ready, which I am hoping will be sometime in August. The Shipping costs last time were approx \$3500 and there will be some items that need to be purchased, costing maybe about another \$1000.

We are asking over the next few weeks if you can please donate to cover these costs in the same way we have done for the previous containers. I am hoping to have required funds raised by the end of July so things are all ready to go when needed. I do ask though that these donations are not made in lieu of any regular giving because that is important as well so we don't get behind on our tight budget.

If anyone has any leads on acquiring 2 good second hand Apple MAC Laptops, please let me know ASAP. If we can get more here, I will take them!
