The band performed in the 2014 and 2015 Adelaide Fringe and have continued to do concerts at Churches in Adelaide and rural South Australia. In 2015 they performed in Sydney, New Castle, Wollongong and the Blue Mountains. The 12 piece band, including strings, consists of musicians from Churches all over Adelaide. They usually perform 2 x 60 minute sets with a 20 minute interval.

*Keith Green was a highly respected musician, and recording artist and one of the biggest gospel singers in the world in the 1970s and early 1980s. Green is best known for his strong devotion to Christian evangelism and challenging others to the same. He was involved in missions, helping people recovering from addiction, prison outreach, evangelism and more.*
