Before worship

Our society doesn't rate 'shameless audacity' very high! It's actually not a common thing to hear even. And when we do experience it we don't often welcome it. It usually asks too much of us.

In Luke 11:1-13, when Jesus teaches us to pray, we are encouraged to be shamelessly audacious in our prayers to the Father. Jesus knows we need to be encouraged to pray and here He gives encouragement to pray again and again and again and again . . . not because God is busy, or reluctant or a bad Father, but because our basic need is for a daily, fresh supply of the bread of life that comes to us by the Holy Spirit, uniting us with Christ and His saving grace.

This reminds me a bit of God's gift of manna in the desert for the wandering Israelites. There was only ever enough for the day (with special provision for the sabbath). If the people tried to gather enough for the next day in advance, it did not stay fresh. They needed to collect God's gift fresh everyday, to sustain their life.

Our spiritual lives, our love of the Father and of His family will flourish much more if we receive a daily fresh supply of grace and forgiveness with the Holy Spirit. Let's take Him at His word and audaciously come again and again seeking all the good and perfect gifts He has for us in Jesus Christ.

Father God help us to value the daily blessings You have in store for those who ask. Forgive us when we ignore or forget You and help us daily ask, seek and knock for Your blessings through continual prayer in Jesus Name. Amen.
