Welcoming Children

Before worship

'whoever welcomes a little child like this in my name, welcomes me' Matt 18:5

My daughter Annelise had a great relationship with my father, her Pop. When she was little she would follow Pop around, constantly asking questions and sticking her nose into whatever he was doing. Pop had a shed in his backyard that was full of interesting things. He had tools for woodwork, a welder, a massive bench grinder and too many car parts to mention. Pop was always tinkering in the shed and the yard. Whenever he had to fix something, make something or invent something, Annelise was right by his side offering her opinion and 'helping'. Pop said to me that it was the happiest time in his life. It didn't matter that a two-hour job now took the whole day; he loved having his granddaughter with him.

Jesus asks us to take that same attitude with the children that are entrusted to us here at Golden Grove Lutheran Church. He asks us to welcome children just as we would welcome him. Take worship for example, it's a challenging thought. We often talk of being a church that is welcoming to children but that means that we may be inconvenienced or that our worship service will look different to what we are used to. It is very common for us to start worship acknowledging lesus and welcoming him, after all that's why we're here. How would worship look if we acknowledged our children and did whatever we could to welcome them? That's the task for us.

We know the grace and love that we receive from God is beyond anything we could experience apart from him. It refreshes our soul and empowers us in our daily lives. Can we welcome our children into that experience just like Pop embraced Annelise in his tinkering? I know we have a heart to do it. I know that we value children like Jesus does. Let's welcome our children with the love that we receive from our Lord.
