Before worship

The two readings this week really highlight the theme of faith. I encourage you to now take time to read the two passages (Hebrews 11:13, 8-16 and Luke 12:32-40). As you would have read from the passage in Hebrews it has listed a few people in the Bible who kept their faith in God and did great things in this world. People like Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, and Sarah. When I read the passage today to write this article I felt comforted (especially as I am in a stage in my life when I am finishing my degree and will be looking for a job). It is all about trusting and having faith in God even when you have no clue with what God is doing! How does this passage relate to you and your life situation?

I really like the next passage from Luke (although it is quite challenging) that we are encouraged as Christians to not be afraid as God has great happiness to give us in the Kingdom. It also suggests for us to sell our possessions and give to those in need. Have you done this before? Is God calling you to do this today (Maybe to help with the Papua New Guinea container)? We also need to be dressed for service and we need to keep our lamps burning as we are waiting for our master to return from the wedding feast. Then we will be ready for when He will arrive. The last sentence of this passage then puts everything in perspective... 'you also must be ready all the time, for the Son of Man will come when least expected' (Luke 12:40). Are you ready?

Dear God, thank you for your word that we can read and get perspective on what is important in this life. Help us to continue to seek you in everything we do. Please help prepare us for when you will come again. We do not know when but in the meantime help us live by faith and not by sight. Also, help us to have the courage to stand up for our faith and live our lives fully for you. Please keep everyone safe, healthy, and well over the coming week. In your name I pray, Amen.

Asaroka Container Appeal

UPDATE

We are coming towards the end of the appeal but **are still a long way behind where we need to be.** By next Sunday 14th August, I need all donations that are intending to be made either put in the collection plate in an envelope marked "Container Appeal", or handed to either myself, Pastor Greg or Judith Whites or direct deposited into the Asaroka Bank Account with the LLL. Account Details: BSB-704942, Account-129176 referenced for 'Container'. You may have to add "S1" at the end of the account number. **NOTE!** If you intend to give but for whatever reason can't for the next 3 weeks, please speak to me so I can note the pledge.

The amount we receive here by next Sunday will directly impact IF and what other important items that are needed get purchased that are not donated.

We are currently at \$2360. We have now got the official quote from the Shipping Company. The costs are as I was predicting (approx. \$4500). However, due to the change of the \$US vs \$AU since 3 years ago, (*the shipping industry works in \$US*) the final price was about \$1100 higher than my prediction only because of this! The final quote is \$5628.57. This includes Shipping, Transport (To Docks), Fumigation & Seaworthy Certificate.

We will be using money currently in the Asaroka Account as well, but as I said we need to get the appeal very close to this total otherwise other urgent goods will not be sourced, which will include Power Tools & Hand Tools, some Sporting Gear/ Accessories and an Apple MAC Laptop for training for this software.

Please prayerfully consider your urgent response to this appeal.

Prayer healing get together:


Prayer Healing get together this Wednesday night 10th August 2016 at 7.30pm at the Napier's **Windsor Gardens**.

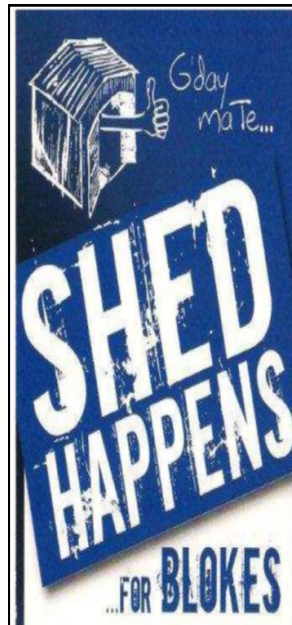
