Receiving what has been promised?

Have you been watching the Olympic Games? It's easy to become caught up in the excitement of the different sports, and for a few weeks we become experts in judging sports we may never have even watched before (well, not since the last Olympics...).

Think about the life of many athletes – training for many hours, every day, in anticipation of becoming the best in the world. But then so does each other competitor in their sport. Winning Olympic gold can be a life ambition for many, and everything they do revolves around this single opportunity. However for each event there can only be one gold medalist – and the disappointment is clearly visible – even when they are awarded silver or bronze.
