Growing through being generous

He has enabled you to share in the inheritance that belongs to his people—Col 1:12

Being generous doesn't come naturally. Whether it's our time or our money, our instinct is to allocate the minimum to the cause. That is why extreme generosity usually gets into the news. Just this week Bill Gates was in the news because he and his wife have given away more than \$30 billion to charity. That's a lot of money and it represents about one-third of their wealth. No less amazing is the homeless man in Colorado, USA who pushed strangers' cars that had become bogged in a snowstorm just because he saw the need. These acts warm our hearts and also make us look at ourselves.

As Christians, we have more reasons than others to be generous. As Paul says in Colossians, we have received an inheritance from God and enjoy His favour. Jesus tells us that God knows our needs and will look after them simply because he loves us. Finally, Jesus gave everything for us so that we could live abundantly and eternally. We have no fear of the present or the future since both are in God's hands. Our Lord asks us to live that reality, being generous and trusting Him with our whole life. Let's focus our eyes anew on the promises and faithfulness of our Lord. When we do, we find that generosity does come naturally.

Site: Coobowie Caravan Park (on eastern side of Yorke Peninsula - between Stansbury and Edithburgh)

Suggested Bait: Cockles, Squid, Pilchards, Gents, Berley etc

You are required to make your own bookings for cabins and powered or unpowered sites. There are plenty of sheltered campgrounds for those that are keen to take along their tent, camper trailer or caravan sites if you prefer.

Approx costs:

Cabins - range from \$65-\$140/night for 2 people Caravan & Tent sites - range from \$22-\$27 night for 2 people School Retreat has 3 rooms of 7 beds and 1 room of 11 beds approx. \$25.00/night/person

Getting There: Self Drive (approx 223 km) or Car Pool (under own arrangements)

Other costs: The evening meal on Saturday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$10/head. You will need to bring your own food for lunches and breakfasts. Yorketown or Stansbury are close by if you need supplies.
