### Before worship

### God, the Good Father

See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! I John 3:1

One of my favourite new songs is *Good Good Father* by Chris Tomlin. The line that always gets me is: 'I've heard the tender whisper of love in the dead of night'.

It's a wonderful description of the heart of God, our Father. It is an image I'm drawn to because it gives us an insight into the powerful emotions and actions that God has for us. God's affection for us is tender and His love is powerful; it is transformative particularly when we are feeling that we are surrounded by darkness. It is natural to view God, the Father as powerful, creative, sustaining and regal. When He intervenes, things change radically, whether it is at creation or liberating the nation of Israel from Egypt. We can depend on His actions and promises.

It is less intuitive to see God, the Father's heart breaking for us when we hurt and His love shown to us emotionally. Yet this is what the bible says. It testifies to our Father's deep emotional tie to us, His children. When we understand this truth and open ourselves to experience the Father's heart, we enter into a profound place of peace and well-being. It is one thing to know that we are precious children of God, the Father, it is another to experience His love so that our emotions are affected by His.

One of the ways that the Father's love embraces us is through His promise never to lose hope in us. There are times when we lose hope in ourselves, those close to us or even God, but He refuses to believe that we will remain apart from Him. The parable of the prodigal son is an example of the Father's love that Jesus shared. God, the Father believes in us and is waiting to embrace us when we turn to Him. May we praise the good, good Father!
