Before worship

I read recently of a discontent and mean spirited man who made his wife promise to put all his money into his coffin with him when he died, so he could take it with him to the after life. When he finally passed away, his wife dutifully placed a box within his coffin just as it was lowered into the ground. On questioning by a friend the woman replied that she had indeed done as he asked. She had carefully banked all his money into her account and written him a cheque for the full amount, enclosing it in the box. This made me smile, how clever of her to fulfill his wishes in this way and to show the absurdity of his request, for as the reading in James points out, 'we can't take anything with us.'

Many times we too hoard and make big plans for how we will use our riches - even when they are meager by worldly standards, but because of our broken natures, they are not always God honouring plans. The promise for today that, "true godliness with contentment brings great wealth' is a real topsy-turvy way of looking at life. But what a challenge! If we can take our eyes off the idol of money and focus instead on our wonderful God and His riches, content in trust of His generous heart, then we will know what great wealth is. There will be enough for our own needs and enough to be generous to others. Why should we need more? The account of the rich man and Lazarus surely shows us that it is not how much we have but what we do with it that is important.

Dear Lord, As we hold tight to that eternal life to which You have called us, please be central in our lives and over our hearts, thoughts and actions so that, inspired by the safety of Your love and care, we can be content, generous to others and rich in You. In Jesus Name we pray, Amen.



Financial Update for 2016

As of the end of August we are 2/3 of the way through the year and to meet our end of year target we would need our income to be between 68% and 72% of budget by this time. Our income is currently 59% of target, which is well below what we need to achieve. Expenditure is 64% and the cash flow position is satisfactory.

Without any increase in giving for the next months, our end of year deficit is predicted to be \$17,500.

Just to match the expenditure for the remaining months of this year, we would need an increase in personal giving of 20% (not taking into account recent pledges) which would bring us to an end of year deficit of \$7,500.

If your current giving is: \$10 \$25 \$50 \$100 \$200 Then an increase of 20% would be: \$12 \$30 \$60 \$120 \$240
