Before worship

For all the Before Worships I have written in the past I have encouraged you all to read the Bible texts for the week before you read the devotion. So, for this week I invite you to go find your Bible and read 2 Timothy 2:8-15 and Luke 17:11-19. From reading these two passages I have come up with some key points (You may have had the same or maybe something different). The text from 2 Timothy 2:8-15 challenged me that we are to work hard so we can present ourselves to God and receive His approval. We need to be good workers who are not ashamed and who correctly explain the word of truth. I feel so often we strive to present ourselves well to others and try our best to get other people's approval. However, how many times do we strive to get God's approval and do things for God's glory?

From the Gospel reading in Luke 17:11-19, we are reminded of the importance of giving thanks. How often do you give thanks for what God has done in your life? Maybe you were healed, got the job you wanted, and/ or God provided in a way that you needed at just the right time. I encourage you to stop for a moment or two and spend time thanking God for what He has done in your life. I believe there are seasons in our lives that we rely and thank God for everything; however, there are probably other seasons in our lives where we don't (usually when things are good and we are comfortable). I pray we can all continue to learn and step forward in faith to be aware of how God shows up and works in all the seasons of our lives.

Dear God, thank you for life, health, and every good. Please remind us daily that you have a plan for our lives and we have a purpose. Help us to fix our eyes on you and what you have in store for our life. Please help us to continue to have faith in you even when life is tough. As well, please keep everyone safe and well over this holiday period. In your name, we pray, Amen.

Financial Update for 2016

As of the end of August we are 2/3 of the way through the year and to meet our end of year target we would need our income to be between 68% and 72% of budget by this time. Our income is currently 59% of target, which is well below what we need to achieve. Expenditure is 64% and the cash flow position is satisfactory.

Without any increase in giving for the next months, our end of year deficit is predicted to be \$17,500.

Just to match the expenditure for the remaining months of this year, we would need an increase in personal giving of 20% (not taking into account recent pledges) which would bring us to an end of year deficit of \$7,500.

Then an increase of 20% would be:	\$12	\$30	\$60	\$120	\$240
