Before worship

Are your ears painted on??

If you recall hearing this from your parents as a child, then you're not alone... I'm sure my parents said it to my brother and myself on more than one occasion. Remember those times when we were asked to do a chore (that we didn't want to do), or told about an event that was happening (to then ask repeatedly "what was happening?"), only to be reprimanded with those stern words – "Are your ears painted on!" We talk about 'selective hearing' as a joke – until the word "chocolate" is mentioned – or the Tim Tams packet is opened – and then there's nothing wrong with our hearing at all.

I'm sure our heavenly Father must feel like this at times about us as well – when He puts people across our path who need us to show them Christ's love in their life, and we step around them or walk straight past (usually because we're too busy to listen, have too much else to do, or it's too uncomfortable...). But then we may turn around to God and question if He is really there when we strike difficult times.

In the reading from Timothy, Paul reminds us to "Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favourable or not." (4:2), and "Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you." (4:5b) God doesn't wait until you're in a good place or it's the right time – being a Christian isn't something we can do when it suits us, and neither can we pick or choose whom we share Christ's love with. When God speaks to us we simply are to listen and respond – He knows what is good for us, better than we know ourselves.

Keep your ears open to hear His word (I hope they are not just painted on...) and be ready to act.
