Last week Pastor Greg mentioned social media as a place where anger prevailed. Recently something there made me angry too.

The first words that appeared on the feed purported to be God saying,

"You will accept me as your Lord and Saviour or I will punish you forever."

Under this was a horrible picture of a man beating a woman, supposedly his wife.

Finally, beneath this, the punchline in bold angry text said, 'That's how Christianity works'.

I was stunned, cross but mostly sad for this was such a twisted view.

The 'punishment' is not God's choice for us but is mankind's destiny without Him! We are not beaten into submission by God but God releases us from submission to Satan and all that oppresses us. In Him is freedom and choice, in Him is hope, love and faith. There is joy in knowing Him.

Paul who suffered enormous trials in his efforts to speak the Gospel tells of his experience of God as one who stands alongside and comforts, one who gives strength, one who delivers and rescues and will safely escort us to our heavenly home. And when He returns in glory it will be to present crowns of righteousness to each one who has longed for His appearing.

Thanks be to God that through our Lord and Saviour Jesus we can know the truth of grace. There is no punishment for our sin, no condemnation, no awful judgement to fear. Just in asking God to have mercy on us in His name, we are included in the company of those who are exulted, those who are loved and precious in His sight, those who will reign victorious wearing the crown of Christ's righteousness.

Lord God, help Your Church to live in the freedom and glory of grace so that just as Paul wished, all people may hear and see the good news of grace and will meet the 'true You', face to face. Amen.

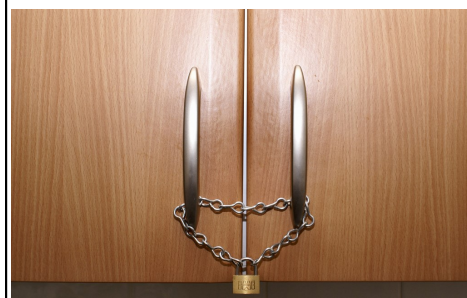
