The Armour of God

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full Armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. Ephesians 6:10-11

Lots of people wear protective clothing in their workplaces these days. There is a recognition that a safe environment needs to be established before any productive activity can begin. It seems that everywhere you look fluoro vests and safety barriers abound. On the sporting field athletes, like cricketers, are more confident and effective when they have the right protective equipment.

As Christians, we have God's armour to protect us so that we can confidently and safely do his work in the world. He would never send us into any situation without his guidance and presence. In Ephesians, the Apostle Paul gives us a good description of the mighty armour that God places on us as his people. We have the truth that sets us free.
