Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight

Proverbs 3:5-6

Getting lost is easy for me. I have a terrible sense of direction and orientation. Shopping centres are difficult for me to navigate because each wing or level looks the same to me. Connie says that if she wanted to get rid of me, all she needs to do is take me to the middle of a large shopping centre, turn me around three times and leave me to my own devices. I would end up wandering around in a daze for ages. It was the same for me when I had to drive somewhere. Fortunately, Google maps now directs me turn by turn, no matter where I am going. How I love the sound of 'in 100 metres, turn left'!

It is easy for us to feel lost in life. We can feel directionless or we may have lost our orientation. Where once we had a grasp of where we were headed, events, tragedies or daily pressures can make us feel as if we are adrift, pushed along by the tide. Our God speaks directly to this situation. He promises to be with us, always, to the very end. We can trust His promises completely. The question we need to ask ourselves is: Are we willing to be led by God?

Our Lord is keen to direct our lives, step by step, if necessary. The more we depend on him the more we will see his leading in our lives. As the verse from Proverbs says God will straighten out the kinks in our lives, he will give us vision for the way ahead, when we submit to his authority in our life. Because our God is a good Father, we know that wherever he leads we will be fulfilled and joyful. He knows us better than anyone else and he has our best interests at heart.
