Please note a quorum of 50 people is required for new business that will be presented at this meeting so we encourage the support, attendance and involvement of folk in this decision-making process of our church.

Financial Update for 2016

As of the end of November we are 11/12 of the way through the year and to meet our end of year target we would need our income to be between 91% and 93% of budget by this time. Our income is currently 90% of target, which is on the lower end of what we need to achieve. Expenditure is 93% and the cash flow position is satisfactory.

Based on historical giving prior to our recent appeals, our end of year deficit is predicted to be approximately \$10,000.

Thank you to everyone who has made an extra contribution in the last few weeks. The projected deficit is now half of what was predicted last month, entirely due to extra giving.

But we are still in the negative.
