Before worship

Today the reading from Isaiah has a passage that I love to turn to in difficult times.

"Do you not know? Have you not heard? God is..." Is 40v21 and v28

I enjoy the repetition of this, it takes me through the false beliefs I have been telling myself to ask again what I really believe is true.

It goes on to describe God's majesty, the One who has no equal.

"The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth" Is 40v28

Sometimes I need a strong reminder of this. But it is the next part of the passage that really encourages me - where God shows Himself as the good Father to all the 'grasshoppers' (v22) of the world.

Now that He has our attention He reminds us that the things we are struggling with - weariness, tiredness, powerlessness, lack of understanding, weakness, falling into sin - these are the very things that God wants to help us with.

He understands. He does not grow weary in creating and sustaining the world or this little life of mine. He gives strength. He increases power. He enables and through Jesus we know He forgives. He's only a prayer away, and He promises to help us.

"Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength, will soar like eagles,

will run and not grow weary, walk and not be faint" v31.

Father God thank You for making us Your blessed children. Forgive us when we forget! Help us call You our Blessed Dad and to treat You as the One who does love us and is capable and longing to help us. Amen.

Do you have an issue with calling God, Father or even Daddy? This is what we are exploring this week in our series "Before Amen".

"Father" is a wonderful name for God. However it also sets up barriers most of which come from our relationship with our earthly father.

How can we call God, Father?

Today I will remind you of two gifts God has given us to break down those barriers.
