As you are reading this, I am on the final leg of the 2015 HANDS Bike ride for Timor - travelling 900km in 9 days. Being involved in this is very similar in many ways to our own (GGLPS & GGLC) involvement and partnership with Asaroka in PNG. At the heart of all that these people do is faith in God - this incredible faith that God will and does provide everything we need to do his work .

Even being on the bike ride we feel God's hand with us - providing safety on the journey, providing hot showers, donated food, and friendly hospitality at the end of each day. The Brave and their Bibles

Under intense bombardment at Gallipoli, Lance-Corporal Elvas Jenkins was struck directly over his heart by a lead ball from an exploding shell. He would have died instantly, but the ball hit his Bible, the New Testament he carried in his shirt pocket. The Bible saved his life that day. But Elvas did not survive the war.

Volunteers Needed across LCC

Barossa:

- **Tax Help** - Help others in the community complete basic tax returns. No experience is necessary and full training will be provided by the ATO. We are in need of someone for a minimum of four hours per week from 1 July - 31 October at our Tanunda site. Blair Athol Op Shop:

- Volunteers are needed at the Blair Athol **Op Shop** for the following tasks:
- moving stock (will require people who are physically capable of lifting heavy items, a couple hours each week or on a needs basis)
- maintenance of garden (on a needs basis)
- driving van to pick up and deliver stock (current Driver's Licence required).

Blair Athol Emergency Relief:

- **Emergency Relief Workers** - work 1 day per week (9.00am-3.00pm) interviewing and assessing people who visit for assistance. Computer skills are essential but specific training is provided.
- **Cooking Class Volunteers** - work one Monday per month (10.30am-1.00pm) helping people with food preparation, cooking skills, and cleaning up when finished. Knowledge of basic recipes is required and you will be working with a maximum of six people per class.

Peachey Place Living Skills Centre, Davoren Park:

- **Cooking Class Leader** - needed on Wednesdays to teach people basic cooking skills. Volunteers can commit to one Wednesday per fortnight or per month if unable to commit every week.
- **Garden Leader** - lead a gardening group on Wednesday and Friday, 10.00am-12.00noon, teaching people to grow their own vegetables. Volunteers can commit to a Wednesday or Friday if unable to volunteer on both days.
