<u>When:</u> Fishing days are Saturday <u>11 Jul 2015</u> and Sunday <u>12 Jul 2015</u>. Fishing locations will be selected during days prior to the event dependent on weather etc. Previous trips have included surf fishing at Locks Well, Talia Beach and Mt Camel Beach and Jetty Fishing at Elliston.

<u>Getting There</u>: Self Drive (approx 688 km), or Bus (approx cost \$100/person) or Car Pool

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be **8.00 am** on Friday <u>10th Jul 2015</u> for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Cnr Sunnybrook Drive & Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am. Arrival back in Adelaide will be at about 6.00 pm including a stop for lunch along the way.

Other costs: The evening meals on Friday and Sunday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$20/head for 2 meals. It is envisaged that we will go to the Elliston Hotel (walking distance) for a meal on the Saturday night. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a supermarket and bakery in the Elliston township (walking distance).
