Before worship

This week our readings are from Acts 10: 44-48, 1 John 5: 1-6, and John 15: 9-17. I encourage you all to open up your Bible's to have a read. What stands out to you? How can you apply what you just read to your everyday lives?

God calls us to obey his commandments. Those who do obey his commandments are born of God and have overcome the world. You will be filled with joy and your joy will make you complete. Jesus tells us to "love each other as I have loved you" (John 15:12). What are some ways Jesus has loved you? Now how can you love others? (I encourage you to write them down). We see in the Bible that there is no greater love than someone laying down their life for his friends (John 15:13). This text come up on ANZAC day with all the celebrations and commemorations we have, which is a great reminder of what people have selflessly done for others. How can you adapt this concept in your life? I personally, love this next part that "you did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit- fruit that will last" (John 15:16). It is such a great reminder that God chooses us to do great things in this life to make a difference in other people's lives. This may be at your work, school, family, sports club, church community or other commitments you are involved in to bear fruit that will last like love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23).

Heavenly Father, thank you for blessing us with life, health, family and friends. Please remind us that you are always with us and that you are always helping and guiding us. No matter what, you are with us. Please help us to love one another like you have loved us first. We surrender our lives to you now. Your kingdom come and your will be done, Amen.

Getting There: Self Drive (approx 688 km), **or Bus** (approx cost \$100/person) **or Car Pool**

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be **8.00 am** on Friday **10th Jul 2015** for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Cnr Sunnybrook Drive & Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am. Arrival back in Adelaide will be at about 6.00 pm including a stop for lunch along the way.

Other costs: The evening meals on Friday and Sunday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$20/head for 2 meals. It is envisaged that we will go to the Elliston Hotel (walking distance) for a meal on the Saturday night. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a supermarket and bakery in the Elliston township (walking distance).
