The events of Pentecost were quite amazing! Imagine being there - what would we have made of it? Rushing wind, tongues of fire, abilities to speak in unlearned languages, new and incredible boldness without regard for personal safety. The disciples publicly testified to their own belief in Jesus as God's Son - died, risen and ascended.

With the personal arrival of the Holy Spirit, the promised gift from Jesus, suddenly the disciples knew Jesus even better than they had when they walked and talked with Him. Their doubts were completely gone. Their understanding was illuminated and the scriptures were clearer and they had a love for their fellow man that made them completely oblivious to the personal danger they put themselves in by their public confession. Never before had they attempted public preaching!

Can this be the same Holy Spirit that we have? I'm joking of course - there is only one, - it's just well sometimes I look at my own life and despair at the lack of progress in my spiritual walk, and not every part of the church on earth is healthy either . . . Where is the boldness, the understanding, the dedication, the love? But I'm not meant to be looking at me or even judging the church – Jesus is the one I should focus on and He is the one with the power for change. If you feel like this too I hope you will join me in this prayer.

Lord God, please can I have a personal Pentecost every morning as I confess my sin and start the day with You? Fill me with faith, boldness and love, equip my mind to understand and my tongue to speak of You this and everyday. Fill and grow Your Church with the Holy Spirit, in Jesus' Name Amen.

<u>Getting There</u>: Self Drive (approx 688 km), or Bus (approx cost \$100/person) or Car Pool

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be **8.00 am** on Friday <u>10th Jul</u> <u>2015</u> for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Cnr Sunnybrook Drive & Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am. Arrival back in Adelaide will be at about 6.00 pm including a stop for lunch along the way.

Other costs: The evening meals on Friday and Sunday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$20/head for 2 meals. It is envisaged that we will go to the Elliston Hotel (walking distance) for a meal on the Saturday night. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a supermarket and bakery in the Elliston township (walking distance).
