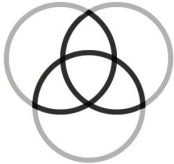

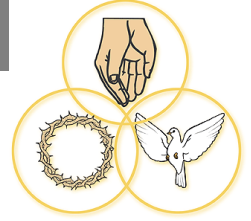

### Before worship

#### Lord send me!

The Old Testament reading for today is from Isaiah 6:1-8.

Isaiah has a vision of being in the heavenly temple where God is being worshipped.

“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty” is the chorus he hears.

In this setting Isaiah is acutely aware of his sinful nature. He in fact fears for his life.

To be in God’s presence in his way, to see God so directly, was understood to be something no human being could experience.... You’d die in such a setting!

Isaiah exclaims “My destruction is sealed, for I am a sinful man, a member of the human race. Yet I have seen the King, the Lord Almighty!”

Wonderfully Isaiah then hears the amazing words “Your guilt is removed. You sins are forgiven.” These are followed by the Lord asking “Whom should I send as messenger to my people. Who will go for us?”

Spontaneously Isaiah responds “Lord, I’ll go! Send me.”

Isaiah had no idea what this would mean for him. It turned out to be a really tough journey. A venture in faith. But an adventure with the Lord is full of surprises and blessings.

Across Australia around 2000 men a month attend Shed Night. These are God's men who are striving to become 'better blokes'.

Shed Night meetings are not limited to a tin shed one night a month. They can happen anywhere at any time. The critical element is awareness of other men and sensitivity to what they are going through. Ultimately, it is God's image being reflected when men step out to get closer and develop deeper, more honest relationships with other men.

Shed is a place where men learn to connect with other men, and where they help each other to become 'the real deal', champion sons of the King of kings.
