Before worship

Trusting God with your life

As I read through this week's readings to write this devotion, I was both challenged and comforted. The first reading was from 2 Samuel 5:1-5, 9, 10 and it's about David becoming king over Israel. I love how this story is full of leadership lessons. A big one for myself and many young Christian leaders face is that David was 30 years old when he became king. For me I know I struggle with the thought about being 20 and wanting to be in a leadership position however, God tells us to wait patiently for him to call us to our positions to be in leadership. Often, we see people in the Bible being called to leadership positions and ministry when they are 30 years old or older (Jesus is another fantastic example). What does that mean to you? Do we see that in today's churches? The second reading was from 2 Corinthians 12:2-10 where we see Paul boast of his weakness. Do you like admitting that you have weaknesses? What are your weaknesses? Who knows your weaknesses? Sometimes I feel we try so hard these days to be perfect and to hide our weaknesses. Is this what we should do? We as followers of Christ should delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions and in difficulties. This is because when we are weak our God is strong (2 Corinthians 12:10). The Gospel reading was from Mark 6:1-13 and we read Jesus being rejected in his home town and Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith. Do you see this in our community here at Golden Grove Lutheran Church (GGLC) where we are rejecting Jesus and showing a lack of faith? How can we change this and live as God's children to help the lost get found and give hope to our community here at GGLC?

WEST COAST FISHING TRIP

The GGAF Trip to Elliston on Eyre Peninsula is not far away. There are still a number of seats available on the bus for this fishing adventure.

When: Fishing days are Saturday **11 Jul 2015** and Sunday **12 Jul 2015**. Fishing locations will be selected during days prior to the event dependent on weather etc. Previous trips have included surf fishing at Locks Well, Talia Beach and Mt Camel Beach and Jetty Fishing at Elliston.

Getting There: Self Drive (approx 688 km), **or Bus** (approx cost \$100/person) **or Car Pool**

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be **8.00 am** on Friday **10th Jul 2015** for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Cnr Sunnybrook Drive & Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am. Arrival back in Adelaide will be at about 6.00 pm including a stop for lunch along the way.

Other costs: The evening meals on Friday and Sunday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$20/head for 2 meals. It is envisaged that we will go to the Elliston Hotel (walking distance) for a meal on the Saturday night. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a supermarket and bakery in the Elliston township (walking distance).

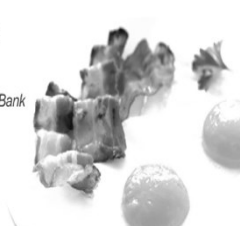
