## Before worship

### God has a plan (even if we can't see it at the time...)

Sometimes it's hard to see the good in a situation – with the terrorist threat, serious illness and death constantly in the news. However in all things God has a plan – and everything occurs as part of God's bigger plan for salvation. I don't know if Phil Walsh was a Christian or not – although growing up in Hamilton, Vic. it is not easy to escape the influence of the church, and his son was an Immanuel College old scholar, so perhaps God was at work in his life. And, dying in such brutal circumstances causes people to question – where is God?

Two of our readings for today tell of situations of contempt and death which may also have caused God's people to question – where is God?

However the reading from Ephesians reminds us the in ALL situations God gives us His blessing and keeps His promise of our eternal inheritance and salvation – and 'At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ'. John the Baptist' work was done – preparing the way for Christ, and King David celebrating the return of the Ark of God to its rightful location – even if others were not impressed by David's celebration.

During our hard times and pain, may we be strengthened by this knowledge, and work together with those offering a hand or shoulder – just as those playing AFL games across the nation have stood side by side in remembrance of a great player and coach – knowing that God makes everything work out according to His plan.
