Bread for the World - Yes, it really is!

'Bread has played an important role in many cultures. The Bible uses the words "bread "and "nourishment' interchangeably. The word "companion" comes from a Latin word meaning "one who shares bread." The sharing of bread and salt is a traditional basis of hospitality and creates a usually unbreakable mutual obligation of protection. Today, we can sample the types of bread from almost every culture around the world. It is still one of the staples that all cultures have.'
