Paul advises us to live wisely, making the most of every opportunity. Our natural natures are the opposite – foolish – not because we all do 'stupid' things but because by our sinful natures we cannot understand what the will of the Lord is. And as Proverbs puts it, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." Fearing God is not cowering under possible punishment but knowing we cannot be wise in our own understanding, but in all our ways we need to acknowledge Him. Prov $3 \ v \ 5$,6 And there are no multiple paths to this wisdom . . . just the gift and leading of the Holy Spirit that grants faith and leads to thankfulness to God. No wonder Paul so strongly exhorts us to be filled with the Spirit!

Kind Solomon asked for the gift of discernment and was made the wisest man on earth. His wisdom was used well in the leading of God's people yet in his personal life he did not follow God with his complete heart but let his multiple wives lead him astray, to worship other gods. To remain in the flock, to remain part of the body of Christ we need that bread of Heaven, Jesus who is communicated to us by the Holy Spirit.

Lord our God, fill us this and every day with Your Holy Spirit that we may know You and Your wisdom and our hearts will overflow with praise and thanksgiving through the Lord Jesus who has saved us. Amen


