James points out the problem as old as humans, a problem with the tongue! His observation that we can praise God one minute then denigrate one of His created people the next is followed by a warning that this should not be.

In today's Gospel Peter experiences this too. In response to Jesus' question, "Who do you say I am?" Peter is swift and definite to praise Him with the title of 'the Christ', yet in the very next break in Jesus' conversation we find Peter opposing His words. There is a stiff rebuke from Jesus because Peter's mind, "is on human concerns, not on God's".

And we experience this too. It is easy and right to praise God and His Son Jesus but when it comes to allowing Him rule in the world or in our life we are not so quick with the praise! We are very often caught up solely in human concerns and that is part of the reason it is so easy to put others down. We forget that God is in control. Our frustration in life and with other people probably stems a good deal from the fact that often we don't want God to be God, we are not willing to let Him choose our path but like Peter we think our own way is best.

Taming the tongue is not the answer but a change of heart will make a world of difference!

Lord forgive our loose tongues. Help us prayerfully place our human understanding under Your control that we may indeed have Your concerns at heart and be able to treat people with the grace and mercy that You so generously give to us. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
