Manse Working Bees

There is much to be done at the manse in preparation for Pastor Greg & Connie Fowler to move in soon. We are preparing submissions for what needs to be done inside, which will be a huge amount – it is very tired and needs a massive revamp. A lot of this will need to be done by tradies to get it done and because of the scope of work. Outside there is much to do that we can do and we need to get started on it. Basically as a start point, the following is what I want to do to kick this off:

Manse Address: 8 Laredo Court, Wynn Vale

Sunday 18th from 1.00 PM (Outside Only)

Load and take all Green Waste to the TTG Green Waste drop off We will need someone from the TTG Council area in the vehicles to show proof of council residency. (Trailers & Wheelbarrows needed).

Pressure Clean railings etc in preparation for painting.

Start Pressure Cleaning all concrete & paved areas. (Pressure Cleaner Patio Cleaner Heads needed.)

Prepare/patch any timber for painting.

Sat 24th October from 8.30 AM (Outside Only) Please bring some food to share.

Finish any Pressure Cleaning.

Paint railings and some exterior timber.

Replace redgum treads in steps around the path.

Lift, level and re-lay part of the front path.

Re-mulch gardens with fresh mulch. Will get this delivered.

Once this is done, then we can re-evaluate where we are at and plan any further work needed. Please get behind this and join in on the fun and fellowship that these events create. Remember many hands make light work! Thanks.
