If you listen to advocates of popular media and those religions and beliefs based in fatalist attitudes, the population of the earth should have been extinguished many times in the past few years. This money will go mainly towards Floor Coverings & Curtains/Blinds. The job needs to be finished by mid December as that is when their furniture will be arriving to be moved in. A builder has now been engaged for the major works. A lot of work has already been done on the outside via Working Bees with more to happen as needed. Thanks so far for your great support here.

NOTE! We will be keeping outside the house due to works inside but will have access to inside toilet – we will picnic under the carport!

Can we please ask if you park along the street either side to ensure that your car wheels don't go onto the peoples lawned median strips as they all have sprinklers along the kerb and unfortunately some were damaged previously during working bees. Also the next house on the left has Stretched Limos, can we ensure that cars are well clear of his driveway and not parked opposite as they need a fair turning circle to exit. If you like, you can also park at the Church and walk as it is only a very short distance. Please keep in front of the Manse clear.

Sat 21st November from 8.30 AM (Outside Only) Please bring some food to share.

Main Jobs to be tackled will be:

- Remove and replace the back brush fence. (Bring Cordless Drill, Tin Snips, Pliers & Gloves)
- Paint exterior railings. (Bring Paint Pots, Brushes & drop-sheet if have any – I have some there)
- Lift, level and re-lay part of the front path.
- Re-mulch gardens with fresh mulch.

Please bring wheelbarrows, shovels, rakes, gloves & multi-fold ladders if you have them.

Once this is done, then we can re-evaluate where we are at and plan any further work needed. Please get behind this and join in on the fun and fellowship that these events create. Remember many hands make light work! Thanks.
