Please remember to check your emails and look for when you are rostered and if you need to make any swaps please record those swaps on the master copy in the church fover.

#### **Church access and egress**

You will be aware that there have been a few changes to security arrangement at our church. Namely;

- 1. There is now a key pad at the southern entrance any church member can get an access code by contacting Graeme Hoklas and this code will open the electronic door and allow access to the key pad inside the fover to disarm the building.
- 2. The key pad on the western entrance has been removed and so the first/last people in/out of the building need to use the southern entrance/exit.
- 3. There is a sign in/out book in the foyer by the southern entrance.

So what's this all about? Safety, security and increased access for members. (You would be amazed how many times doors to the worship/fellowship centre are left open...)

Members accessing the building during school hours are asked to drop by the office and sign in there.

Members accessing the church building out of school hours should sign the form provided. The door should be shut behind you and you should have a mobile phone on you.

The other doors in the church plant can be used, but please make sure they are locked after you have finished with them.

It is hoped that having a system like this will alleviate some of the issues that have been happening.
