## Pastor's Column

What are your foundations, how important is it to keep them in mind, what happens when we lose touch with our foundations? These and other questions will be answered this morning in my address, "**Know your foundation**" based on the second reading for today (from 1 Corinthians 3) and in particular verse 10 "*By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should build with care.*"

**Jason is giving the message tonight at Salt Factory on this same topic.**

**Next week**, we celebrate the **Festival of Transfiguration**. The message will be about being lifted up beyond the mundane.

### Position Vacant: School Chaplain




**Golden Grove Lutheran Primary School** is seeking the services of a School Chaplain (as funded through the National School Chaplaincy and Student Welfare Program.)
