Before worship

Matthew 4:10 (Voice): Jesus says: "Get away from Me, Satan. I will not serve you".

Temptation is something that we are faced with every single day: not one of us is exempt from the workings of the devil. Temptation manifests itself in many forms with some less apparent than others. Do you find yourself trying to tackle problems in your life by your own strength, telling yourself you don't need anyone else's help? Do you casually talk yourself up in conversation, slipping in your successes as much as you can just so others know? Or do you take pride in your possessions, flashing around your new smart phone just so you can show it off a little?

Overcoming temptations is not easy, but we don't have to do it alone. Jesus was born as a human child and grew up experiencing all that we experience in this world, including temptation. We are not made to endure anything that Jesus has not experienced Himself.

In Matthew 4, Jesus was tempted by the devil but He was victorious. And you know why? Because He relied upon the word of God to see Him through. He too was tempted to rely on His own strength, to increase His reputation by joining Satan's camp and to take possession of what wasn't His to own. But Jesus stood firm in what he had been taught in the scriptures and through the power that He possesses through our Father. God promises us that He will never give us anything we can't handle. 1 Corinthians 10:13 states: 'No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it'.

Prayer: Lord, please continue to give us confidence in you and the knowledge that any temptation we face is no match for you, our Lord and Saviour. Amen.

Welcome all of you to worship today.



A special welcome to **Bethany Swift's family and friends** to our morning worship.
