WELCOME to all worshipping with us today

Greetings to any visitors here with us. We are pleased to have you join us and we trust you have felt welcomed and pray the Holy Spirit may enlighten and empower us with the

<u>Before worship</u>

Jesus is alive!

In these Sundays of Easter (this is the fifth, and note the Easter candle is lit every service during this season) we are seeing what it means that Jesus is alive.

In the first reading (Acts 7:55-60) we look with Stephen- (in verse 56) " "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God"- at Jesus in the place of authority and honour. We know he is interceding for us and preparing a place for us in heaven. It also shows the consequences of Stephen's sermon, which had just preceded this text- his martyrdom and his incredible ability to forgive!

Peter in the second reading (1 Peter 2:2-10) describes the risen Lord as the living Stone—rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him (verse 5).

And how we too are living stones and he quotes the prophecies from Isaiah 28, Psalm 118 and Isaiah 8 (verse 6-8). It leads to that beautiful description of who we are because Jesus is alive: verses 9, 10- "you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession", with a purpose- "to declare the praises of him".

Just how you do that, we learn as we walk with Jesus.

The Gospel reading (Matthew 9:1-8) is a description of our theme for this term, "Walking with Jesus", and today, "into a house (and he forgives)".

You'll see (overleaf, in the pastor's column) I take that up as that passage up in the address this morning.

message shared with us today.

I love the crowds response to Jesus: "When the crowd saw this, they were filled with awe; and they praised God, who had given such authority to man." (Verse 8)

He had that authority when he walked this earth over 1980 years ago and now that he is risen, this is fulfilled in us. He has given that authority to us, as he walks with us!

Prayer: Thank you Jesus that you have risen from the dead, to walk with us through our life. Father, fill us with your Holy Spirit that we may not only "see" you this morning through your Word but also confess you, praise you and forgive others as we have been forgiven. Amen


