Pastor's Column

How are you feeling?

In many ways each Sunday is a "*Palm Sunday experience*". We are welcoming Jesus **anew** into our lives. Our whole worship experience is just that – from welcoming him in the 'Invocation', to being open to Him speak to us through His Word (and Sacraments) and inviting Him in our lives through some of our songs.

So it isn't really strange to be celebrating **Palm Sunday in June**, especially considering this is the next main story in the book of Matthew we are "walking through".

Do you have you that feeling of **anticipation**, even excitement? – "What is God going to say to me and do for me today? How is this worship going to change me?"

In the address this morning "Walking with Jesus into Jerusalem", based on Matthew 21:1-11, we'll join in the celebration of today, but we'll also pause to notice three important aspects of the event: that Jesus knew, Jesus was a different kind of king than what was expected and the humility of Jesus and we'll consider just what each of those aspects means for our lives. I believe this will lead us to a much deeper celebration- which is not only for our worship today but for every day of our life.
