Before worship

"There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus". Romans $8\ v\ 1$

Did you hear that! I mean really 'hear 'that?

There is NO condemnation because "through Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death." v2

Does that make your heart sing? Do you feel a load fall off? Do you want to jump for joy?

Sometimes it is hard to believe that we who disobey the laws of God can still be worthy of salvation. Perhaps this is because we see the law only in terms of punishment and consequence, what we deserve! Nicky Gumble of Alpha fame sees it differently:

"The tragedy is that God's desire was actually to bless them (His people). His commands and instructions were given to them so that they might flourish."

If we see the Law on these terms - as a way for God to bless us and make us flourish then it is logical to see that His loving heart would choose another way, a better way for us to receive the blessing He has always wanted us to have. As so through Jesus Christ, there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. Jesus came, "In the likeness of sinful humanity, to be a sin offering. And so He condemned sin in human flesh in order that the righteous requirement of the Law might be fully met in us".

Baptism into His Name confers His death and life on us. His righteousness prevails in us. Thanks be to Christ, there is now no condemnation on us, blessing is the order of the (eternal) day instead.

Lord this really is good news, Fill our hearts with faith and joy. May we truly flourish in Your Name Amen.

Pastor's Column

Welcome to **Hugo** and his family and friends for this the most important event in his life: his baptism. Listen to the promises in the service that God is making to him today and take to heart that God made those same promises to you at your baptism.



Today in the message I shall be speaking on another "Living Psalm" - a song from the Bible that is alive and relevant for us today.

The Psalm for today (Psalm 119:105-112) gives a vivid image of how we can be guided through life: the lamp. The writer of this psalm presents this image with confidence, joy, praise and thanksgiving.

As we consider how we are guided through life, we'll see that God has provided a light shining in the darkness for us. What is that light? How do we allow that light to give us confidence, joy, praise and thanksgiving as well? How can we use that light, especially in the dark times of our life? These are just some of the questions that I shall be answering in the message this morning.

Again this evening at Salt Factory we'll look deeper into this psalm to see what having that light means for us today.

Next Sunday the theme for the service is "A tree blessed - growing by streams of water" based on Psalm 1.

I shall be on **annual leave** from 21st July to 3rd August.

I have noticed that the pastor's columns have been shorter over the last few weeks and I have asked myself why? I put it down to the season we are in. During school holidays many aspects of the congregation are put on hold (as people go away) and I have annual leave in the near future; it could be that I am waiting for where the congregation feels we should be going at The Gathering and this has been postponed (till the 14th September) and likewise it could be that we are in the process of the latest "pastor's appraisal" and this is taking some time to organize; or could it be (and I have heard about it in other congregations too) just a general lack of enthusiasm? I wonder.
