### Before worship

#### What is the Church?

There are many answers to that.

Jesus in this morning's Gospel reading (Matthew 16:13-20, p 671) lays the foundation- "the Rock" on which it is built. Is it Peter? (That's what his name means). Some people have thought that and a whole ecclesiology (understanding of the church) is built on this with a structure (hierarchy) of the Pope, bishops and priest... Surely though, the answer is his confession of the Faith/ the Truth, inspired by the Holy Spirit. It's who Christ is. It's the Gospel message. It's Grace. This is basis of the Church. This is what we are on about.

And it's on this basis that the second reading (Romans 12:1-8, p. 776) means so much. God has given each of us gifts. Paul in this passage pictures that as "members" of the human body but elsewhere he speaks of the Church as a building (Ephesians 2). We are to build each other up (see 1 Corinthians 14) with the gifts God has given us. And so, what is your gift? How are you using it? How can you improve it?

You will notice this morning we have replaced the first lectionary reading with the thematic text: Psalm 91 (p. 408). It is the basis of this morning's address, especially verse 4, referring to being covered by feathers. It is actually another expression of God's love for us. (More about that in my column overleaf.)

Today the *Living Psalm* is **Psalm 91** and in particular **verse 4: He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge;** with that beautiful image of being covered by feathers. Of course the image makes most sense when we see ourselves as the chick. (In the image I have downloaded as an eaglet.)

This morning we are going to have a closer look at this image by applying it to Christ and ourselves. The theme for this morning message is "**Covered by Christ**".

We'll see that Christ covers us with his protection, warmth and continual care.

I pray that this may comfort you, reassure you and give you confidence.

This evening in **Salt Factory** James Norrey will be giving his insights into this Psalm.

**Next Sunday** the *Living Psalm* is Psalm 103 and in particular verse 13, with the image of compassionate father. Pastor Len will be delivering the address.

We also plan to admit 17 young people into the Sacrament of Altar/ have their First Communion/ **Step Up to Communion**. I hope you can join us for this most significant event in these young people's lives.

This marks us offering grape juice as well wine into the morning service and grape juice only in the Friday Morning Holy Communion services.

**Approx costs: Homestead - \$50/person for the 2 nights**  
**Ocean Pod - \$170/night for 2 people**

**Campsite - \$31/night for a vehicle carrying up to 5 people (includes amenities)**

**Getting There: Self Drive** (approx 290 km) or **Car Pool** (under own arrangements)

**Other costs:** The evening meal on Saturday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$10/head. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a small shop adjoining the homestead that supplies treats, ice, bait and fishing tackle.

**Camp fires:** are allowed. Please be sure to bring your own fire wood or buy wood from the shop. Collection of fire wood from the bush is strictly prohibited.
