Happy Fathers' Day today.

In this morning's service we shall be hearing what the book of Proverbs says about fathers, especially from the angle of wisdom and all fathers present will be receiving a special blessing.

The children have a gift for all the men today and are putting on a special Fathers' Day morning tea.

This morning we shall be walking with the pilgrim passed the dangerous mountains to the refuge of the holy city.

The symbol for this week is the **mountain**. The theme for this morning is "Safe from danger" and the Living Psalm is Psalm 121:

- ¹I lift up my eyes to the mountains where does my help come from?
- ² My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.
- ³ He will not let your foot slip he who watches over you will not slumber;
- ⁴ indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.
- The LORD watches over you the LORD is your shade at your right hand;
- ⁶ the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.

The questions I pose to you this morning are:
Are you in danger? Where do you find safety? And, is that place really safe?

At Salt Factory this evening is a *Camp Fire Service* again having a closer look at Psalm 121 based on the symbol of mountains.


It is a fun production and features some great singing and acting.

The homestead and 2 caravans have been booked. There are plenty of campgrounds for those that are keen to take along their tent or camper trailer or caravan.

Bookings: If you would prefer to stay in the homestead, caravan or an ocean pod please contact Louise Sumner 0419811945 <u>sumnerl@icloud.com</u> as soon as possible as accommodation is limited.

Approx costs: Homestead - \$50/person for the 2 nights Ocean Pod - \$170/night for 2 people Caravan - \$55/night for 2 people Campsite - \$31/night for a vehicle carrying up to 5 people (includes amenities)

Getting There: Self Drive (approx 290 km) or Car Pool (under own arrangements)

Other costs: The evening meal on Saturday night will be catered for at a cost of approx \$10/head. You will need to bring your own food for lunch and breakfast. There is a small shop adjoining the homestead that supplies treats, ice, bait and fishing tackle.

Camp fires: are allowed. Please be sure to bring your own fire wood or buy wood from the shop. Collection of fire wood from the bush is strictly prohibited.
