Before worship

The people said to Moses, "Speak to us yourself and we will listen. But do not have God speak to us or we will die".

The people at the foot of Mt Sinai are shocked by God's revelation of His power, His holiness, His majesty, His all knowing. They know that they can never be in God's presence or even hear His audible voice and live. They know they need an intermediary to shield them from direct access with God for they can never fulfill His righteous requirements.

In Paul's letter he lists off all the pure ways he had lived and all the things he had done that would bring Him praise from people. A Jew beyond reproach, full of zeal and fervour for God, but Paul knows that not one of these will win him any favours with God. Paul too requires an intermediary, because he is a sinner and would surely die in God's holy presence!

In the face of what God has done in Christ he sees the dross of all his strivings and considers all he has been proud of as dirty rags. Instead, Christ is everything and Christ is enough! Enough even that he can forget the past and trust only in Christ.

Christ gives to Paul and to all Christians a righteousness that surpasses that of Moses, that surpasses anything a human is capable of. He gives us His own righteousness through Baptism into His sinless life, His death and resurrection.

Now we are in Christ, sharing His righteousness, the very pure and holy nature of God Himself. Now we can bear words spoken to us by God without fear of death or condemnation and we can even enjoy His daily presence with us. And God's words are words of love and forgiveness and hope, things that we could never receive without God's gift of Jesus Christ.

Lord, speak to us through Your Word today, encourage us with forgiveness and hope. Thank you for the surpassing right-eousness we have in Jesus Name, Amen.
