### Before worship

"Keep your gentle nature so that all people will know what it looks like to walk in His footsteps. The Lord is ever present with us" (Philippians 4:5, VOICE).

Be encouraged. That's a strong message that is described throughout God's word. Through the Bible, you can "meet the God of encouragement. He loves you. He never gives up on you, especially when life is hard, because He has been there. The hand that reaches out to comfort you is a pierced one" - Max Lucado.

Think about the people of Israel who were waiting in the desert with Aaron and Hur. Moses had left, and the people began to question lots. They were stubborn. Easily swayed. Impatient. Traps you and I fall into daily. And they built this golden calf to worship, because they weren't seeing God anywhere else in their struggles. Not good. And God was not happy. He huffed, threatening, but didn't puff. "God relented and decided not to destroy the people as He had threatened to do" (Exodus 32:14). And through Jesus, this same decision from God is true for us. We are not guilty.

Give encouragement. We are invited to God's house. In the Parable of the Great Feast, the high-fliers rejected the King's offer for a banquet, so his servants "went into the streets and invited everyone they met, rich and poor, good and bad, high and low, sick and well" (Matthew 22:10). We have met the King through our faith. We have accepted the olive branch to be forgiven and redeemed through Jesus. And not only are we invited, we are chosen! You are special, and that encouragement comes directly from the Bible.

Be encouraged by Paul's words in Philippians 4 (VOICE) to give encouragement to others today. "Most of all, friends, always rejoice in the Lord! I never tire of saying it: Rejoice! Keep your gentle nature so that all people will know what it looks like to walk in His footsteps. The Lord is ever present with us...Finally, brothers and sisters, fill your minds with beauty and truth. Meditate on whatever is honourable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is good, whatever is virtuous and praiseworthy.
