Before worship

I can see clearly now...

While starting to write this, I thought of a number of quotes or sayings about light, and did you know there are over 900 documented quotes about light? Everyone from Martin Luther King to Shakespeare; people sing about it, write stories and poems, and use it to inspire generations. The Bible even has 100 verses which reference Light.

When you experience a black out everything looks different – the dark seems darker, shadows more obscure, you stumble – unsure of your footing, and it's even difficult to see the people around you (even when they are right along-side of you). Fears and anxieties can overwhelm you, sadness creeps in and you long for it to end. But with the light returned nothing is hidden, and calmness returns – like flicking a switch.

Knowing Christ is like having light brought into your life – whether the light has always been there, or if you took a while to find your way to the light, or whether you had it – then lost it for a time – and found it again, the Light of Christ gives us strength, reassurance, comfort, guidance. It makes our life clearer, and makes it harder for the darkness of the world to take control.

Can you see the blue sky? Can you see the bright, sun-shiny day? Are you praying for rainbows?

Pastor's Column

Today I shall be preaching on the next section of the book of **1** Thessalonians (5:1-11) about the encouragement to live in the light.

Paul says we live in the light but have you noticed any difference between those who live in the light and those who don't? Perhaps we don't realize that we are in the light or that we don't know what the light really is. We'll explore that thought today in the address this morning and my message at Salt Factory this evening.

We welcome the Korean Christian Church to our 9.30am worship. They will be joining us on the 3rd Sunday of each month.

One reason for them joining us is to receive **Holy Communion** on a regular basis.

To put the **emphasis on Holy Communion** today we are having it at a different place- earlier in the service (a place where we often have Holy Communion in our evening Salt Factory service- after the confession and absolution)

I shall be away next Sunday at St Peter's, Callington to lead the congregation in their 150th anniversary celebrations. **Pastor Lyle Bartel** shall be leading the service here and Pastor Len shall be conducting Isaac's Ennis' Baptism.


