Before worship

Pastor Lyle mentioned it last Sunday, have you felt it too - that unease with all the judgement readings we have had in the last weeks of the church year? When we look at ourselves we see some attempts at good works, at kindness and loving others but we mostly reflect on all the things we have done wrong or the good we haven't done that we had the opportunity to do. And so the doubts creep in . . . will God really save the likes of me?

What a tonic today's Epistle reading is! The opening sentence tells us immediately what God's intention is all about – 'Grace and Peace' for His children – not judgement. Just as the angel told the Shepherds at Jesus' birth, 'Peace on earth and goodwill towards all mankind.' Jesus' whole purpose in coming the first time was to take away judgement, to take our punishment so that we are cleansed, to make peace for us with God.

Then following in our passage today we have that declaration, "God is faithful." He won't change His mind! He has decided and declared that we are blameless in Christ and it is also His promise that we will be kept firm in this grace and peace until the end, until Christ returns and unites us with the Trinity and the whole body of believers in the heavenly realms.

And that is the message of Advent. The focus is on repentance so we can enjoy the anticipation and excitement of waiting and share the peace, joy, hope and faith that are ours in Jesus Christ.

What can we say Lord, except we are sorry, and thank You. Amen.

Pastor's Column

Welcome to the family and friends of **Callum Window** who will be **baptised today**. Pastor Len is officiating at this baptism.

Welcome too to **Melissa Balnaves** and **Dale Bruce's** family who have come to support them in their **confirmation of their baptism.**

And **another special welcome** to Andrew Tillers Year 4/5 class and their families who are presenting the theme in this morning's worship service.

How do you feel about WAITING? What do you do as you wait? What can help your waiting? This morning we are using the second reading (Ephesians 1:3-9 and in particular verse 7 *Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed*) to think about "*eagerly waiting*" and what God gives us as we wait. Please consider some of these things we only get as we wait. Doesn't that put waiting- *eagerly waiting*, into a new light?

Could you use the **Christmas play flyers**? We have produced flyers promoting our Christmas Eve play (and a couple of other events around Christmas). **Why not** give these to your neighbours (or put them in their letterbox), insert them in a Christmas card which you are sending/giving to someone close to our church or put a small pile in local businesses (with their permission)?

Christmas is giving.

- On the morning of Sunday 21st December as part of our children friendly/ carols and reading service you will have an opportunity to come forward with an offering in cash or cheque, in an envelope or as a promissory note during the service, **as an extra offering**. (There will be 2 offerings that day.)
- This is based on truth that Christmas is a time of giving. God gave us our Lord Jesus, as John 3:16 put it "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son...." And He invites us to respond to his gift to us with our giving.
- The giving will be to support our ministry at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship ("the Budget").
- If you are not able to attend our worship on Sunday 21st you are encourage to give on Sundays either side (14th or 28th) or on Christmas Day through an enveloped marked with "Christmas is Giving" or through a one off special giving through REG.
- (Our Christmas Eve offering will still go to ALWS- Australian Lutheran World service.)

In the "Keep in mind" below you will notice that the Half Yearly meetings (school and church) is happening TODAY. I hope you plan to stay for it.

In the agenda booklet, which is available this morning, you will notice a couple of proposals that I would like to draw your attention to.

- From the Gathering, the proposal of a **name change**. I think it is essential that we identify ourselves in a form that people recognize: GOLDEN GROVE LUTHERAN CHURCH.
- I fully endorse **Pastor Chris Mann**'s involvement in our congregation.
- The proposal <u>re</u> 9.30am. worship services in 2015 at GGLF. I have suggested this proposal "to test the waters". I have had a lot of strong feedback on the services being too long and this proposal would address this. The two negatives about this proposal are: 1. people won't have the freedom to choose any Sunday to have a baptism. (It will always be the 2nd Sunday of the month) and 2. it reduces people's opportunity to be involved through the rosters on the 4th Sunday of the month it will either be the School, the Kids at Heart Team or I leading key parts of the service. I would like to know your feelings about this, so I have raised it as a proposal.

Keep in mind:

- Our Christmas (church/school) picnic coming up on 7th December after our 10.30am (NOTE CHANGE OF TIME FOR THIS WEEK) service.
- Our Salt Factory service on **14**th **December** will be a carols by candlelight "camp fire service".
- Heidi and I will be away in Brisbane, from 12th December to 16th December to take time "in lieu".
- The morning service on 21st December will be a carols and readings service with the children acting out the Christmas story.
