Pastor's Column

On behalf of Heidi and myself and the staff in our church office, Judith and Sarah, we wish all of you, A VERY BLESSED CHRISTMAS.

This Bulletin covers Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and the first Sunday after Christmas- the 4th Day of Christmas (28th December) and it's the last bulletin for this year.

If you are reading this on **Christmas Eve**, I hope you enjoy and get a lot from this year's play **"The Busy Inn keeper"**. It asks a very pertinent question at this time of the year...

If you are reading this on **Christmas Day**, the theme for this morning's service is "**How do you respond to the unexpected**" based on part of the Gospel reading for today (**Luke 2:8-20**).

We'll look at how the shepherds responded to the unexpected- an angel appearing to them with that wonderful news of Christmas: 1. with shock and fear, then 2. taking it all in and 3. dealing with it, and how critical it is for us to respond in an appropriate way to the unexpected.

If you are reading this on **the Sunday after Christmas** you'll have the opportunity of hearing the second part of "*How do you respond to the unexpected*", based on the Gospel reading for that Sunday(**Luke 2:22-35**) and how God may come to us in "unexpected ways" during worship as well. Again the crucial factor is how we respond. We'll look at the old man Simeon's response to see what we can learn from that incident.

Next Sunday marks the conclusion of our *Christmas is Giving* campaign.

As I have been letting you know over the last few weeks, this offering is based on Christmas being a time of giving. God gave us our Lord Jesus, as **John 3:16** put it "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son...." And He invites us to respond to his gift to us with our giving.

The giving will go towards our ministry at Golden Grove Lutheran Church ("the Budget").

I have encouraged you to use an envelope that you have marked with "Christmas is Giving". (As I said last week, this is only for statistical purposes. Give in whatever form you desire.)

We have received over \$1000 in cash that we know of through this campaign. I am sure we shall receive more through REG and an increase in general giving to the congregation.

Also next Sunday we shall be celebrating **April Braun's baptism** and so remembering our own baptism. What a wonderful way to start this New Year.

We haven't normally been holding **New Year's Eve services** at GGLF, over the last few years (FYI we did in 2007, 2009, 2010), but I encourage you to worship on New Year's Eve. **St John's Lutheran Church TTG** is holding a Holy Communion service at **7pm on New Year's Eve.**

Remember no Salt Factory Services, Sunday evening dinners or "Reaching Out Through prayer" through the month of January.

On the **Sunday 4th January 2015** we shall be having an **exchange of pulpits with Balaklava Parish.**

Pastor Jim Bryan will be leading here at GGLC and I shall be leading services at Auburn and Balaklava. (This is the 3rd time (in the last 4 years) that we have had this particular exchange.)

If you haven't heard, I have received CALLS from Carlsruhe-Saddleworth Parish (3/12/14) and (most recently) from Berri parish (13/12/14).

Please pray for me as I deliberate on whether I should accept either of these calls (and leave our congregation at Golden Grove) or continue here.

Of course I am open to you talking to me about these calls and my current call here to Golden Grove.

Food for thought over the holiday period



Christmas message from our Bishop

"Life in our world during 2014 was unpredictable and at times frightening.

Passengers on two aircraft never reach their destination and one plane simply vanishes. The Ebola virus threatens. Innocent people suffer unspeakable cruelty and terror. That threat touches our previously safe shores in the Sydney siege. And a young man loses his life playing our national game......

We long for life to be manageable and under our control but it rarely is. How many times this year were we beyond our capacity to deal with what was happening in the world out there and in our own personal lives? "Our thoughts and prayers are with them" were words and sentiments uttered even by people who aren't known for praying.

Christmas says the one we call out to when life is out of control is not far away. He is as close as a baby, the baby called Jesus, a name meaning "Saviour", and Immanuel, meaning "God with us".

In a time of uncertainty and fear someone recently tweeted #I'll ride with you - to assure those who were afraid that they are with them and willing to walk with them. In Jesus, God came to earth to walk with us in, and through life. His first sound would have been a cry, just like ours. His last sound was also a cry when he gave his life for the world. He is near, he understands better than anyone, and he was born to help and save us. That's why Christians turn to him and we pray in his name.

Christmas is precisely for anyone who struggles with life, whose heart is crying over things and people they have lost, over regrets and guilt, over what their life has been or could have been, and for anyone who fears the future. Christmas is about God joining us in the struggles and joys of life, here to give us a future none of us could ever deserve.

"Peace on earth....." the angels cried out in the dark at Christmas. Despite our best efforts, world peace and inner peace will always elude us. Ultimately peace comes from outside ourselves, it is a gift from God that resides in a person, someone who promises "I am with you always". May you know his presence and his peace at Christmas and in all of life, whatever it may bring in 2015."
