Before Worship...

Ephesians 3:

vs 4 and 5 "In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets.

Vs7 I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ.

Vs 12 In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence"

In his letter to the people of Ephesus, during his two year imprisonment in Rome, Paul wrote to help the Ephesians understand the dimensions of God's eternal purpose and grace and come to appreciate the high goals God has for the Church. His message was to emphasise the importance of **unity** – all Christians are one family in Jesus and they should act with love toward each other.

I have always been impressed with Paul and the passion of his writings. Just read Romans. He was ever humble ("although I am less than the least of all the Lord's people" vs 8)

I hold him high on a pedestal and cannot envision myself to ever be as influential as this wonderful servant of God.

Prayer: Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for the peace and grace granted to us through your Son and our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Help us through the congregation to reach out and share your love with others so that they will also come to know Jesus and share in your promise of eternal life. In Jesus name we pray. Amen,

Pastor's Column

Aren't mysteries intriguing? Life holds many mysteries. The word "mystery" appears 4 times in the second reading for today (the festival of the Epiphany). Paul is referring to the greatest mystery of all there in **Ephesian 3:1-12** and it's on this that I am going to base this morning's address: "The Mystery". I pray that God shows us that there is an aspect of this Mystery that can be understood, an aspect that needs to be revealed and an aspect of which we can only stand of awe.

On this morning in which we contemplate the Magic of bringing gifts to Jesus in worship, isn't it appropriate to consider what we are **bringing to Him each week** in our worship? Are what we bringing for the offering plate a true expression of our thanks to God and our desire to promote the mission of our congregation?

Also as we start this new calendar year I encourage you to take up again your spiritual disciplines. We are promoting the **Daily Bible Readings** here at GGLF (listed on the back page on the Weekly bulletin for that week or in a booklet form in the foyer).

Also in the foyer pick up any of the **literature** that is there for you (some of it may have been placed in your pigeon hole so check them as well). There are still some copies of the discussion paper "The Golden Grove Way".

I hope you (who have given us your information) have received your "enews" this week. (a email this previous week promoting the coming Sunday.) If you didn't get this email then perhaps we don't have your email address. Please inform the Manna (communications) Team, listed in last week's Bulletin and we'll rectify that.
