1 But now, this is what the LORD says-- he who created you, Jacob, he who formed you, Israel: "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze (Isaiah 43)

I love the first reading for today (*first 2 verses - before you*) because I hear God speaking to us! We are the chosen ones! We are created for his glory, we are "precious and honoured" in his sight" (as he goes on to say). It's faith that permits me to hear that and if I didn't have faith, all of the things that I am dealing with: "*the rivers*', "*the fire*" would be so much harder.

This passage reminds me that I am privileged to be chosen by God and what is ultimately important is my walk with God. I need not be afraid whatever I go through for God is with me.

May we have this faith as we come for worship and may God strengthen our faith this morning so that we can face the week ahead with confidence.

Prayer: Father, thank you that you have given us faith to attend worship today. Strengthen our faith in you through your Word and Holy Communion. And help us not only respond with our faith in our singing and prayers now but throughout this coming week as well, in Jesus name. Amen.
