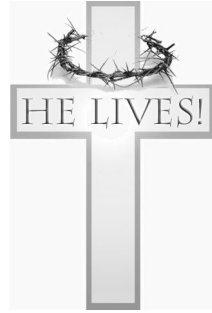

Before Worship

Stop and Think...

How often do you think about the Easter story? We regularly celebrate the risen Lord – as we should – for giving us life. But how often do you stop and think about what **you do** which caused him to hang on the cross in the first place?

Maundy Thursday – Jesus sharing that final meal with his disciples, only to be betrayed and deserted by them a few hours later. Do you enjoy the celebrations, but when the 'hard work' of being a Christian is required, you are nowhere to be seen? Do you freely and openly admit to being a Christian – around your friends, to your work colleagues, at school?

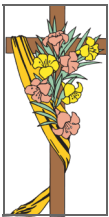
Good Friday – Are you part of the crowd, getting swept along in the excitement of it all, that you end up shouting "CRUCIFY" before you realise what you are saying? Each time you curse or wipe your hands of committing to the reality of your faith, you hammer a fresh nail into His flesh.

Resurrection Day – Do you walk straight past your Risen Lord, not recognising him in the faces of the poor, the disadvantaged, the oppressed? Do you look for him among the dead, rather than fully acknowledging that He is truly alive and living among us?

Pray that this Easter, and always, that your life may be a true reflection of the **New Life** we receive and celebrate.

Asaroka Fundraiser – Fishing Fete Charter Raffle


