Before Worship

I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and beneath the earth and in the sea and all things in them echoing the messengers: "To the One who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honour and glory and power throughout the ages". (Revelation 5:13, Voice).

Our God converts people from wherever they are at. Stubborn, scared hearts are transformed into lively hearts who seek to glorify His name. Saul was a fuming, raging, hateful man who wanted to kill every last one of the Lord's disciples (Acts 9:1). Yet Jesus enters in, orders him to get up and fulfil his God-given purpose (Acts 9:6) - and changes his name to Paul. Peter denied knowing Christ three times, showing his lack of faith in God's power and strength (John 18:27). Yet Jesus reaffirmed His love to Peter three times, calling him to become a humble follower of Christ and a great leader of the church (John 21:17). In the same way as Paul and Peter, two important leaders in the early church, God calls us to be changed by his everlasting Spirit. I'm always astounded that God offers the ultimate transformation: a new life in Him. Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! (2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)) Won't you leave your old life behind for the new life that God has gifted you?

Prayer: Merciful God, thank you for showing to us that we don't have to be perfect to follow You. Help us to shine through You and be converted into the men and women, Your children, that you intend us to be. In Your name, Amen.

Pastor's Column

Welcome to the Principal, Peter Hasu and teachers of Asaroka Lutheran Secondary School who are joining us for worship this morning. I hope you –the members of GGLF are joining us for lunch after the worship this morning to get to know a little better these teachers of the School in which we are in partnership.

We continue looking at the book of Revelation in the message this morning. The theme is "A picture of heaven" based on Revelation 5:11-14.

It seems as though there are many people these days who have been to heaven and have come back to tell us what it is like! All that we can be sure about heaven is what the Scriptures give us. From my reading of Scripture I see three different pictures: Paradise - a beautiful garden- a return to Eden; a feast - a Wedding Banquet with Christ himself as the groom. And this picture here- Worship (Revelation 5:11-14): a temple or a palace, angels, God's glory.

This is awesome, breathtaking: praise - directed to God.

So what about *us*, what about *this* life? We trust that we will enjoy this when we get to heaven but what about now? Can we have a glimpse of heaven?

There are three gifts God gives us: Gratitude, Unity and Peace which do give us a glimpse of heaven. They allow us to get ready for it and appreciate what it really is.




